RE: Amendment and Summary of Material Modification

This Amendment and Summary of Material Modifications ("**SMM**") amends the U.A. Plumbers Local Union No. 68 Group Protection Plan (the "**Plan**") effective as of the dates listed below. Covered individuals should read this SMM carefully and keep it with their copy of the U.A. Plumbers Local Union No. 68 Group Protection Summary Plan Description.

Effective March 18, 2020: Diagnostic Testing for COVID-19 (Coronavirus) that is prescribed by a licensed healthcare provider will be covered at 100% by the Plan, without cost sharing and will not be subject to Plan deductibles, co-payments, or co-insurance. This includes items and services furnished to individuals during provider office visits (whether in-person or via telehealth), urgent care visits and emergency room visits that result in an order for, or the administration of the test described above, but only to the extent such items or services relate to the furnishing or administration of the test or the evaluation of whether the person needs the test.

Note: Upon receiving a positive diagnosis, the care and treatment of COVID-19 operates under established Plan benefit levels that will be subject to Plan deductibles, co-payments, co-insurance and out of pocket maximums. Effective March 25, 2020: If you need to obtain an early refill of your maintenance medication in order to make sure you have enough on hand in the event of a quarantine period, the Plan will temporarily suspend the refill-to-soon edits to allow for you to get your refills if you have used 50% of your supply.
